Add the minimalist and stackable stool by ASK

Add is a stackable stool made by the german studio ASK. A design studio specializing in the development of furniture products. Its founder, Steffen Kehrlé creates products and objects for companies of international renown in the areas of product, exhibitions and industrial design.



Add is a stool designed to brand **Stattman Neue Moebel**. A German company that in recent years has focused its production on manufacturing high quality wood products. Through this design any user can see reflected the values of the brand: high quality, research, tradition and functionality.



Add is a minimalist product of aesthetics and simple lines with a strong timeless character

Made of three legs and a frame that gives the product of great stability and consistency. The different pieces that make up the product, run the product in a fluid way creating a smooth and simple transition between the legs and the frame. Its size allows it to be a piece that can perform the function of seat or side table. A product that is robust in terms of material but very lightweight visually. The legs and frame are made of solid wood, and the plywood seat. The surface is dyed with water based pigments and the plugs under the legs are made of wool felt.



A unique product since the wood used to make the Add stool comes from controlled sustainable forestry. In this way each piece of wood has a grain and a different color.



Its minimal form and aesthetics, together with its timelessness and its stackable quality provide the product of great versatility. This generates that it can be used as much as an additional stool in the home. Or on the other hand, as an exhibition space for public and private spaces.
